BEN STRONG - Center, Guilford College

Strong, a senior from Chapel Hill, North Carolina, averaged 28.0 points, 11.0 rebounds and 1.5 blocks in the Quakers' 2-0 week. He shared game-high scoring and rebounding honors with 21 points and 10 boards in the Quakers' win over Methodist. He netted a game- and season-high 35 points, plus 12 rebounds in the Quakers' road win over N.C. Wesleyan. Strong netted 25 points in the second half, which helped Guilford rally from a six-point halftime deficit. He also had two blocks in the game. Strong scored 30 or more points for the ninth time in his career, moving into eighth place on Guilford's career scoring list with 1,629 points. He also moved into 11th among the school's career rebounding leaders (671).

Riley had two more double-doubles overall and was the games leading scorer in two of the three games. She collected 19 points in wins over Averett and Mary Baldwin and then had 14 points and a season high six assists in a 76-63 win over Randolph College. Riley leads the team in scoring (16.7 ppg), rebounds (8.1 rpg), and steals (19). She ranks fifth in the conference in scoring, sixth in rebounds, and is second in steals per game (3.60).

Team Notes: The EMU men's basketball team faced off against Randolph College this week in a precursor to an ODAC showdown in the 2008-09 season. EMU struggled to find the bottom of the net as the Royals shot only 18 percent in the first half and 31 percent overall in a 57-53 win. Senior Jered Lyons led all scorers with 22 points to go along with three steals while reigning ODAC Player of the Week Brad Parkes had his second double-double of the season with 19 points and a team leading 12 rebounds. The men's team will wrap up the first half of the season before Christmas break with a conference game against Bridgewater College on Saturday, December 15, at 7 p.m., in Ninger Hall. The EMU women's team wrapped up a successful three game week with the Lady Royals also moving up in the ODAC standings.

Emory & Henry Wasps

Team Notes: The Wasps defeated Greensboro in their only game of the week. E&H cashed out 20-of-54 three-pointers with Josh Cunningham (18 pts.) hitting six, Andrew Hart (19 pts.) five and Camillo Weinz (17 pts.) five.

Guilford Quakers

Top Scorer: Ben Strong - 27.0 ppg.
Top Rebounder: Ben Strong - 11.2 rpg.
Team Notes: Guilford was ranked seventh in the Dec. 3 D3hoops.com Top 25 Poll... Ben Strong scored 30 or more points for the ninth time in his career with a season-high 35 points at N.C. Wesleyan. He moved into eighth place on Guilford's career scoring list with 1,629 points and into 11th among the school's career rebounding leaders (671)... Guilford held Methodist to 48 points, the fewest by a Guilford opponent since Nov. 20, 2004, a span of 85 games... the Quakers made 26-of-28 free throws (92/9%) in a road win over N.C. Wesleyan... Tyler Sanborn grabbed a career-high 14 rebounds at N.C. Wesleyan and added 10 points for his second double-double... the Quakers are outrebounding their opponents by more than 24 boards per game through their first five games of the season.

He backed up that performance with a 17-point performance on 6-7 shooting in just 25 minutes due to foul trouble in a 74-70 win over Randolph College.
