During the five-game span, King shot 51.9 percent from the field and 52.9 percent from three-point range. King was also named the Most Valuable Player at the 2007 Weenie Miller Holiday Hoops Tournament.

Hiltunen also grabbed a team-high seven rebounds in the victory. Hiltunen helped R-MC cap its trip with a 60-40 victory over Villa Julie the next day when she tallied 12 points. In each of her two games in Phoenix, Hiltunen recorded four steals on the defensive side of the ball for the Jackets.

Men's Team Reports

Bridgewater Eagles

Top Scorer: Brandon Trawick - 14.7 ppg.

Top Rebounder: Michael Oblitey - 8.3 rpg.

Team Notes: Dominic Trawick scored 13 of his 15 points in the second half Saturday night to help lead the Eagles to a 59-58 victory over Shenandoah. Shenandoah entered the contest with a 10-2 record. Trawick hit a 3-pointer with 1:16 left in the game to tie the score at 58-58. He then hit 1-of-2 foul shots with nine seconds remaining for what proved to be the winning point. The win lifted the Eagles to 6-1 on the season. On Dec. 15, Trawick scored 14 points in Bridgewater's overtime victory over EMU. In that game Trawick hit two foul shots with six seconds left in regulation to send the game into overtime.

Eastern Mennonite Royals

Top Scorer: Brad Parkes - 19.7 ppg

Top Rebounder: Brad Parkes - 8.9 rpg

Team Notes: EMU lost to cross-town rival Bridgewater on Saturday, December 15, with the Royals on the short end of an 84-83 overtime contest. Brad Parkes had season highs in points (25) and rebounds (13) while senior guard Jered Lyons added another 13 points along with seven assists to the EMU attack. EMU stayed on the road following Christmas break and again lost a close contest at the end, this time to the Cougars of Averett University. Parkes led all scorers with 21 points to go along with a team high eight rebounds.

Emory & Henry Wasps

Top Scorer: Josh Lee - 14.6 ppg

Top Rebounder: Jarrell Christian - 4.6 rpg

Team Notes: Robert Hudson helped lead the Wasps to its fourth win of the season as they defeated Greensboro 100-99. E&H spotted the Pride a 23 point lead in the first half and were down by 15 with 8:00 left in the game. E&H rallied with a 19-2 run that put the Wasps up 90-88 with only 3:32 left in the game. E&H averages 118.3 points per game and is +10 in turnover margin per game.

Guilford Quakers

Top Scorer: Ben Strong - 24.8 ppg.

Top Rebounder: Ben Strong - 11.8 rpg.

Team Notes: Guilford was ranked 12th in the Dec. 31 D3hoops.com Top 25 Poll... Ben Strong has recorded double-doubles in each of his last five games, including a 28-point, 15-rebound effort in the Quakers' road win over Emory Jan. 5. He has a team-high seven double-doubles on the year and 30 for his career. Strong blocked a season-high five shots in the Emory win. He ranks eighth among GC's career scoring (1,692) and rebounding (699) leaders... Clay Henson hit for a career- and game-high 29 points in the Quakers' Jan. 2 win over Averett. The sophomore guard matched Jordan Snipes' '07 school record with nine three-pointers in the win on 13 attempts. He scored all of Guilford's first 17 points and had 20 points at halftime... Eric Belkoski scored a season-high 15 points vs. Emory, his fifth game with 10 or more points.

Hampden-Sydney Tigers

Top Rebounder: Troy Kaase - 7.1 rpg

Team Notes: The Tigers have won their last seven contests, posting a 7-1 overall record heading into conference play. The Tigers won the 2007 Weenie Miller Holiday Hoops Tournament and were the only team to post a 2-0 mark in the Christopher Newport Captains Classic.

Team Notes: Lynchburg has yet to retake the hardwood since it knocked off Christopher Newport 81-79 on Dec. 17. Brad Puffenbarger led the Hornets with 23 points while Jeff Langbrock added eight rebounds to the effort. Kwame Safo had six assists and three blocked shots.

Randolph-Macon Yellow Jackets

Team Notes: Randolph-Macon is riding a six game winning streak as it heads back into ODAC play this week. R-MC has won its last six games by an average of 16 points each time out. Jeremy Dixon averaged nearly 18 points and 8.5 rebounds in four holiday wins for the Jackets, posting a pair of double-doubles and a two MVP tournament honors. R-MC is benefitting from strong contributions from its freshmen with three first year Jackets averaging 15+ minutes a game.
