#### LINDSAY RIESBECK - Forward, Randolph-Macon College

Riesbeck, a junior from Newport News, Virginia, helped R-MC to three wins this week, including a pair of ODAC victories over the weekend. She averaged a double-double with 17 points and 10 rebounds for R-MC this week which now stands at 10-0 overall and 5-0 in the ODAC. Against Catholic, Riesbeck scored 16 points and pulled down 12 boards, while adding three steals in the win. In a big win over Guilford on Friday, Riesbeck scored 15 points, pulled down 10 rebounds and recorded two blocks. She capped off her week with a 20 point, eight rebound performance against the Wasps. She also notched seven blocks.

### Men's Basketball Player of the Week



#### BEN STRONG - Center, Guilford College

Strong, a senior from Chapel Hill, North Carolina, averaged 24.7 points, 10.3 rebounds and 3.7 blocks in the Quakers' 2-1 week. He totaled a game-high 34 points and four blocks, plus seven rebounds in the Quakers' home win over H-SC. He netted 23 of his points in the second half. Strong hit for a team-best 17 points and added nine boards and three blocks, both game highs, in a loss to R-MC. He compiled 23 points, 15 rebounds and four blocks, all game highs, in GC's win over VWC, which helped Guilford end an eight-game losing skid to the Marlins. He made all nine free throws in the game. The contest marked Strong's team-leading eighth double-double of the year and his ninth game with 20 or more points.

### Men's Team Reports

#### Bridgewater Eagles

**Top Scorer:** Brandon Trawick - 13.9 ppg.

**Top Rebounder:** Michael Oblitey - 6.8 rpg.

**Team Notes:** After getting beaten badly on the road at VWC on Wednesday, the Eagles bounced back to pick up a pair of key conference wins on the weekend. Bridgewater held off a later Hampden-Sydney rally Saturday to take a 73-71 win and on Sunday BC rallied from a 10-point second-half deficit to win 85-82 at Lynchburg College. Junior Michael Oblitey scored a team-high 22 points against Lynchburg and hit 6-of-7 3-pointers. Oblitey is now shooting 55 percent this season from beyond the arc. Dominic Trawick hit 4-of-6 3-pointers and led the team with 18 points in the victory over Hampden-Sydney.

#### Eastern Mennonite Royals

**Top Scorer:** Brad Parkes - 18.9 ppg

**Top Rebounder:** Brad Parkes - 7.9 rpg

**Team Notes:** EMU finished off a three-game week going 1-2 and are now 4-6 overall on the year and 1-3 in the ODAC. Brad Parkes has been the consistent scoring threat for EMU as the senior forward registered 21 points in a 92-78 conference win over Lynchburg College and is averaging 18.9 points per game and 7.9 rebounds per game, both team highs. Senior guard Jered Lyons was 4-of-7 from behind the arc in a 86-72 loss to defending ODAC champion HSC, but is averaging 10.6 ppg and is tied for first on the team with 15 steals.

#### Emory & Henry Wasps

**Top Scorer:** Camillo Weinz - 14.3 ppg

**Top Rebounder:** Jarrell Christian - 4.1 rpg

**Team Notes:** E&H currently has a 4-7 overall record, but the Wasps 7 losses have come at the hands of opponents with a 55-35 (.611) record including Div. I Radford. E&H is in a scoring slump - After scoring 100 or more points in its first eight games the Wasps have been held below the century mark each of the last three. Thru last week, E&H led the nation in scoring at 118.3 ppg, but are currently scoring 108.8 ppg. Camillo Weinz may be the exception as he has scored 46 points in the last two games and connected on 10-of-28 (36%) from 3-point range. The Wasps lost to Radford 124-109 in tight ballgame. The Wasps forced 33 turnovers on by Highlanders.

#### Guilford Quakers

**Top Scorer:** Ben Strong - 24.7 ppg.

**Top Rebounder:** Ben Strong - 11.4 rpg.

**Team Notes:** GC was ranked 11th in the Jan. 8 D3hoops.com Top 25 Poll... Ben Strong has a team-leading eight double-doubles on the year and nine games with 20 or more points. He averaged 24.7 points, 10.3 rebounds and 3.7 blocks in the Quakers' 2-1 week... 6-10 forward Tyler Sanborn sat out the second half of GC's game with Hampden-Sydney and did not play against Randolph-Macon or Virginia Wesleyan due to injury. Freshman Martin Stephenson made his first two college starts in Sanborn's absence... Clay Henson continued his torrid January shooting last week with 11 three-pointers in 19 attempts (57.9%). The sophomore averaged 18.0 points per game last week and is shooting 58.5% (24-41) from beyond the arc in five January games... each of the Quakers' last four opponents have entered the GC contest with winning streaks of at least five games: Emory (6), Hampden-Sydney (7), Randolph-Macon (7) and Virginia Wesleyan (5). Roanoke carries a five-game winning streak into Wednesday's home tilt.

#### Hampden-Sydney Tigers

**Top Scorer:** Turner King - 20.2 ppg

**Top Rebounder:** Troy Kaase - 7.6 rpg

**Team Notes:** H-SC went 1-2 on the week to post an 8-3 overall record and 2-2 mark in the ODAC. The Tigers have three players averaging double-figures in scoring. Sophomore Turner King leads the way at 20.2 points-per-game, while Troy Kaase is averaging 16.1 points-per-game and Drew Prehmus at 14.4 points-per-game. Kaase averaged 17.7 points and nine rebounds in three contests last week.

#### Lynchburg Hornets

**Top Scorer:** Mason Wooldridge - 18.0 ppg

**Top Rebounder:** Mason Wooldridge - 7.2 rpg

**Team Notes:** Sophomore forward Mason Wooldridge (New Canton, VA/Fork Union) averaged 24.3 points and 7.3 rebounds while shooting 62.8% overall from the field, 58.3% from three range, and 85.7% from the free throw line in three games this week. He posted a game-high points in each game (27, 21 and 25).

#### Randolph-Macon Yellow Jackets

**Top Scorer:** David Carlson - 14.3 ppg.

**Top Rebounder:** Jeremy Dixon - 7.6 rpg.

**Team Notes:** With three ODAC wins this week, R-MC's winning streak has now reach nine games. It is the longest winning streak since the 2003-04 season when it reeled off 11 straight to start the season. David Carlson helped R-MC to three ODAC victories, including a pair of road wins this week. Carlson averaged 16.3 points in the three games this week, including a 26 point performance in a win at No. 11 Guilford on Saturday afternoon. Against the Quakers, Carlson made 8-of-15 shots, including four trifectas. Justin Short averaged 15.6 ppg, while logging an average of 37 minutes of playing time, including 40 minutes against Lynchburg. Short managed to turn the ball over just three times in his 106 minutes of action this week, with all three coming against EHC's pressure defense.

#### Roanoke Maroons

**Top Scorer:** Curtis Peery - 13.1 ppg
