### Men's Basketball Player of the Week



#### MASON WOOLDRIDGE - Center, Lynchburg College

Wooldridge, a sophomore from New Canton, Virginia, tallied ODAC season highs of 45 points, 20 rebounds, and 11 assists in a 131-118 victory over Emory & Henry on Wednesday. He was 17-25 from the field and 11-11 from the free throw line while also contributing with three steals. The 45 points were the fourth highest in D3 this year and the fifth highest in the NCAA while his 20 rebounds and 11 assists were both in the top 20 of D3 this year as well. He backed up that performance with 28 points and nine rebounds in a loss to Virginia Wesleyan on Saturday. He was 10-19 from the field while shooting 3-6 from three and 5-8 from the free throw line.

Dahn, a sophomore from Glenn Allen, Virginia, earns her second ODAC weekly award of the season. Dahn led Lynchburg to a 2-1 week with victories over Guilford (65-57) and Washington & Lee (62-53). She averaged 18.7 points per game while pulling down 11.7 boards throughout the three contests. She is currently second in the ODAC in scoring and first in rebounding. Against Guilford, Dahn dropped in 18 points to go with an ODAC season-high 18 rebounds. She followed that up with 16 points and nine boards against W&L and 22 points and eight rebounds versus Roanoke (L, 68-74).

### Men's Team Reports

#### Bridgewater Eagles

**Top Scorer:** Brandon Trawick - 14.3 ppg.

**Top Rebounder:** Michael Oblitey - 6.4 rpg.

**Team Notes:** Michael Oblitey scored 18 points and hit 4-of-8 3-pointers to score 18 points in BC's loss at W&L. Oblitey is now shooting 54.2 percent from the 3-point range this season making 26-of-48 from beyond the arc. Dominic Trawick also hit 4-of-8 3-pointers and finished with 18 points. Josh Fox made 7-of-10 shots to score 14 points. The loss at W&L snapped a two-game BC winning streak.

#### Eastern Mennonite Royals

**Top Scorer:** Brad Parkes - 17.5 ppg

**Top Rebounder:** Brad Parkes - 7.6 rpg

**Team Notes:** EMU ran through a difficult part in its schedule. Freshman D.J. Hinson had a big game against Randolph-Macon as the 6-4 wing led the team with 22 points on 9-of-12 shooting from the field while freshman guard George Johnson added another 10 points. Johnson and Hinson are both averaging 7.8 points per game with senior forward Brad Parkes leading the squad with 17.5 ppg.

#### Emory & Henry Wasps

**Top Scorer:** Camillo Weinz - 16.2 ppg

**Top Rebounder:** Jarrell Christian and Antonio Leary - 3.9 rpg

**Team Notes:** Camillo Weinz set three E&H records and two ODAC records in 112-120 loss to Guilford. Weinz scored a career high 35 points as he connected on a school record 11 3-pointers - this mark also tied the ODAC record. His 27 3-point attempts also gave him school and ODAC single game records. Weinz now has 196 career 3-pointers which surpasses Cricker Lauderback's (1992-96) school record of 190. The event of the day (Sat.) was the halftime ceremony celebrating the career of legendary coach Bob Johnson. A record crowd of over 1,200 showed as President Rosalind Reichard declared Jan. 19, 2008, as "Bob Johnson Day," and the College officially unveiled the naming of the King Center basketball court as "Bob Johnson Court".

#### Guilford Quakers

**Top Scorer:** Ben Strong - 24.9 ppg.

**Top Rebounder:** Ben Strong - 11.5 rpg.

**Team Notes:** Guilford was ranked 17th in the Jan. 15 D3hoops.com Top 25 Poll... Guilford's Ben Strong has a team-leading 10 double-doubles on the year and 10 games with 20 or more points. Thanks to a season-high 39-point, 15-rebound, five-block showing at E&H, he averaged 26.0 points, 12.5 rebounds and 3.5 blocks in the Quakers' 1-1 week... 6-10 sophomore forward Tyler Sanborn (7.4 ppg., 9.0 rpg., 1.8 bpg) remains sidelined by a leg injury. The timetable for his return is unknown... a season-high five Guilford students scored 10 or more points in Guilford's 120-112 win at E&H Jan. 19, the Quakers' sixth straight over the Wasps. Strong, Eric Belkoski and George Neville all posted double-doubles in the win, a Guilford first. The Quakers tied a Division III school record with 65 rebounds in the game.

#### Hampden-Sydney Tigers

**Top Scorer:** Turner King - 20.4 ppg

**Top Rebounder:** Troy Kaase - 7.2 rpg

**Team Notes:** Hampden-Sydney is 8-5 overall and 2-4 in the Old Dominion Athletic conference. The Tigers are led by Turner King at 20.4 points-per-game and Troy Kaase at 7.2 rebounds-per-game. King notched a pair of 20-point games last week that included 21 tallies

and 10 rebounds in a loss to RMC. Hampden-Sydney has three games this week, including home contests against Lynchburg on Wednesday and Roanoke on Saturday. The Tigers will travel to Lexington, VA to face Washington and Lee on Sunday.

#### Lynchburg Hornets

**Top Scorer:** Mason Wooldridge - 21.1 ppg

**Top Rebounder:** Mason Wooldridge - 8.4 rpg

**Team Notes:** Mason Wooldridge has moved into third place in the ODAC in both scoring and rebounding. He's also second in the league from the free throw line (.846). Aside from Wooldridge's 45-20-11 night at E&H, Jeff Langrock added 31 points and Kwame Safo 20 tallies in a the 131-118 favorable decision.

#### Randolph-Macon Yellow Jackets

**Top Scorer:** Justin Short - 14.5 ppg.

**Top Rebounder:** Jeremy Dixon - 7.4 rpg.

**Team Notes:** R-MC is currently ranked 25th in the nation by D3hoops.com on the strength of an 11 game winning streak that has propelled its record to 12 overall and 6-1 in the league. The 11 game unbeaten streak matches R-MC's longest streak since the 2003-04 when the Jackets opened the season with 11 consecutive wins. Four R-MC players are averaging double digit scoring led by Justin Short at 14.5 ppg. He is joined by David Carlson (14.3), Jeremy Dixon (13.8) and Jordan Brown (10.1). Brown had a pair of 16-point games last week, shooting 12-of-17 from the field. The R-MC defense has held its opponents to just 37.5% shooting from the floor and has out rebounded their opponents by an average of nine boards a game.

#### Roanoke Maroons

**Top Scorer:** Curtis Peery - 13.9 ppg

**Top Rebounder:** Josh LaPorte - 8.5 rpg

**Team Notes:** At 11-2, the Maroons are off to their best start since the 1999-00 campaign (12-2). They are riding a seven-game winning streak, their longest since 2000-01 (nine). Since January 1, 2007, RC has won 26 of its past 32 games played. Curtis Peery helped the Maroons to two wins last week with 17 points and 11 rebounds against Guilford to go along with 20 points and eight boards against EMU.

#### Virginia Wesleyan Marlins

**Top Scorer:** Ton Ton Balenga - 16.6 ppg

**Top Rebounder:** Tyler Fantin - 7.5 rpg

**Team Notes:** Tyler Fantin posted back-to-back 21 points efforts in wins over Hampden-Sydney and Lynchburg. He shot 17-of-28 from the field over those two contests, also connecting on 4-of-8 shots from beyond the arc. He has now scored in double figures in four consecutive games, six of the last seven, and 10 of 14 overall. Fantin has pulled down 105 rebounds this season, increasing his career total to 621, the eighth highest in VWC history. He is also now just 25 points away from the 1,000 for his career.

#### Washington & Lee Generals

**Top Scorer:** Greg Bienemann - 21.5 ppg.

**Top Rebounder:** Greg Bienemann - 8.1 rpg.

**Team Notes:** In it's only game of the week, W&L defeated Bridgewater 73-67. Greg Bienemann collected his fourth double-double of the season with 16 points and 11 rebounds. Femi Kusimo added 14 points to the effort. The Generals shot 59-percent (28-of-47) from the field, increasing its hold on second place in the conference in field goal shooting (.490 - 313-of-639).
